

THOR

Character Description: The legendary God of Thunder, THOR ODINSON is an Asgardian royal and a powerful warrior. Once arrogant and irresponsible, he learned to be a worthy hero and joined the Avengers to keep Earth safe. THOR was King of Asgard for a time and took his roles as a leader and Super Hero seriously. When he failed to stop Thanos from wiping out half of the Universe, THOR was deeply affected but eventually decided he wanted to do something good and make up for his mistakes. Helping to defeat Thanos made THOR realize he needed to be who he truly is, not who he's supposed to be. He stepped down as King and is now eagerly venturing into an uncertain future for the first time.



Traits: Powerful, Confident, Protective, Worthy

Stance & Movements: THOR has a powerful, commanding presence. He carries himself with confidence while still maintaining a relaxed, approachable air. THOR stands with strong posture, keeping his feet shoulder-width apart and his toes forward or slightly turned out with his weight centered. When he is feeling relaxed, he may stagger his stance, keeping his weight balanced. THOR often stands with his arms at his side, keeping his elbows slightly bent and his free hand relaxed. When he is feeling more casual, he may bring an open palm to his hip, keeping the hammer at his side with his other hand. THOR is somewhat reserved in his physicality when he is not in battle. He reacts naturally to things with strong, controlled gestures.

Facial Expressions: THOR is natural but not overly expressive with his facial reactions. He may smile slightly when pleased, or offer a larger smile when he is truly happy. When THOR is feeling thoughtful, his face is more serious, and he shows surprise by slightly dropping his jaw and furrowing his brow. If he is concerned about something, he raises his eyebrows and tucks his chin a touch. THOR shows determination with focused eyes and a faint smile, as though he expects to enjoy whatever he is about to do.



Walking: THOR walks with a confident, purposeful stride at a steady pace. He swings his arms slightly as he travels, keeping a firm grip on his hammer while his other hand is relaxed at his side.

Voice: THOR speaks with an Asgardian dialect. His voice has a low pitch and a friendly tone. His speech is formal at times. His pitch lowers when he is more serious or commanding.

For an Asgardian dialect: "er/ar/ir/ur" changes to a soft "r" and the "t" is pronounced at times.

When reading, do not focus on the words you are saying, but the thought behind them. Allow your face and hands to move naturally and express emotion as if you were having a conversation. The adjustments for speaking with an Asgardian dialect are emphasized in the readings.

READING 1:

"I am Thor Odinson (*OH-din-son*), of Asgard (*AZ-guard*). Perhaps you have heard of it? Some are still surprised to learn that there are realms beyond this one. What you call Earth is known as Midgard (*MID-guard*) where I come from. There are Nine Realms in the Cosmos, and the fate of each affects all the others. I have made it my duty to keep peace among the realms. I hope you will consider me an ally, and a friend."

READING 2:

"I am Thor, of Asgard (*AZ-guard*). The people of this world used to think me a myth, but here I am! You know, I've been through quite a lot. I fought a swarm of robots...had to destroy my own realm to save my people...helped defeat a Mad Titan ...oh, and I was King somewhere in there, too. Now I'm here. I've always liked Earth. It feels quite homey, doesn't it?"
